Hockey Canada Development 1 | NCCP Competition Introduction

Hockey Canada Policy:

All Head Coaches, that coach teams in **Peewee or above** at **competitive levels**, as determined by the Branch, must be **Development 1 'Certified'** (other than those requiring High Performance 1). It is recommended that all **Assistant Coaches** have **Development 1 'Trained'** status.

Coaching Requirements meeting the Standards established by Hockey Canada and the Coaching Association of Canada (CAC):

1. **Definition of 'Competitive Levels' per Hockey Canada Policy:**

Levels where there is an OHF Championship - **AAA, AA, A**

2. **Requirements by Role:**

AAA, AA, A:	Head Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Certified' Assistant Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained'
Rep Levels Below A:	Head Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained' Assistant Coaches – Development 1 (D1) - 'Trained'

3. **Roster Eligibility:**

- All Coaches must have 'Trained' status to be added to a Team Roster
- Coaches requiring 'Certified' status must complete certification process by:
August 31st of current season

4. **Certification Maintenance / Qualification Renewal:**

- Development 1 (D1) 'Certified' status is valid for 5 years
- 20 Professional Development Points are required to renew certification
- Development 1 (D1) 'Trained' status is valid for 5 years
- The development pathway for Development 1 (D1) 'Trained' Coaches is to move through the certification process **or** after expiry must take clinic again

Hockey Canada Development 1 Requirements

All coaches in Peewee, Bantam, Midget that coach teams at competitive levels as determined by the Branch. Assistant coaches must be D1 trained.

Certification Maintenance

Coaches are required to obtain a minimum number of Professional Development credits, dependent upon the context in which they are certified and the NSO-determined period within which they must renew their certification

Minimum Professional Development Credits required if the period for renewal of certification is:

Certification	5 Years
Competition Introduction	20 Points
